Pool Use Info & Rules For your safety & enjoyment

Memorial Weekend	12:00 Noon until 6:00 PM
Summer hours:	10:00 AM until 9:00 PM



Reminder, we do not provide lifeguards. To ensure a pleasant visit, a pool host/hostess is on duty only during evening & weekend hours to check chemicals, to help monitor the pool and enforce the rules. **They are NOT Lifeguards.** Please give them your respect and cooperation. **Swimming is at your own risk.**

- **State Law: Children 12 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult.** An adult is defined as anyone 18 years of age or older. Parents are responsible to control their children's behavior. Please do not leave children unattended.

- **The pool is for residents only and their invited guests.** However, residents must be in attendance with their guests. Anyone with more than six guests must rent the party house. This is to ensure that chairs and tables around the pool will also be available for other residents use. There will be no exceptions to this rule. Residents are responsible for their guests adhering to the pool rules and must also clean up after their guests.

Persons suffering from **communicable illnesses (such as diarrhea) are prohibited from using the pool.**

- **Appropriate swimwear** must be worn when in the pool. Children not toilet trained must wear the appropriate swimming diapers.

- **Headphones** must be worn when listening to music at the pool so as not to disturb other guests.

- **No glass** is permitted in the pool area. This is per the city health code and the pool will be closed if we are caught in violation.

- **No running, throwing, pushing, dunking, or diving permitted.** Improper conduct will not be tolerated or permitted and pool privileges will be revoked.

- **No pets** permitted in the pool area.

- Management will not be responsible for personal articles left in the pool area.

Keep our community pest free:

Remember to get all the weeds & debris off your patios. These can be breeding grounds for

rodents. Be sure that all trash cans are covered or turned upside down if empty to avoid stagnant water accumulation. For those needing help with spring patio cleanup you may contact **Stan at 614-560-7738. He is available to clean patios for \$35.**

NOTE: If a patio is deemed to be excessively overgrown/hazardous it will be cleaned by staff & the resident will be charged accordingly.
